Open Studies students register in courses, for credit, without committing to a degree program.

Open Studies provides the opportunity to *test the water* for those who are not ready to enter a seminary degree program, or do not qualify for non-academic reasons.

Open Studies students are not considered to be on the 'ordination track' in Lutheran Church–Canada, but their credits *may* be counted toward a subsequent degree program.

Open Studies offerings include courses in all disciplines. Some courses may require prior completion of Biblical languages.

Open Studies offers the opportunity for serious theological study to *everyone*.

Not everyone who studies at CLS is preparing for the pastoral office...

...but everyone who studies *does* have the opportunity to earn graduate level credits that are applicable to other Seminary programs *and* transferable to other accredited seminaries in North America.

Timeline

Applications are accepted beginning in January prior to the Fall Semester (September), or beginning in May prior to the Winter Semester (January); complete applications are accepted up until the first day of classes.

Audit Policy

Students may audit courses for a reduced fee. Credit is not earned for audited courses.

Who Can Apply?

Anyone with an undergraduate degree, the appropriate course prerequisites, and the willingness to learn, grow, and serve is eligible to study at the Seminary.
